We hope you all had an enjoyable and restful Easter break. The term has started well and we are all in the swing of things. We hope you enjoy our new look newsletter which has some new features.

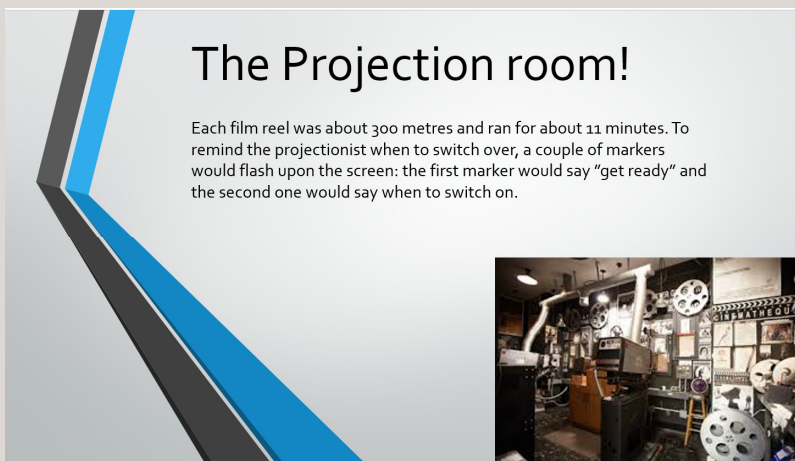
Each week we will showcase some learning across the school that shows variety, depth and engagement. We are very proud of what the children learn at Friars and how they go about learning and want to share it with you.
