Don't forget that next Monday is a bank holiday and school will not be open! We will see you all again on Tuesday 3rd May.

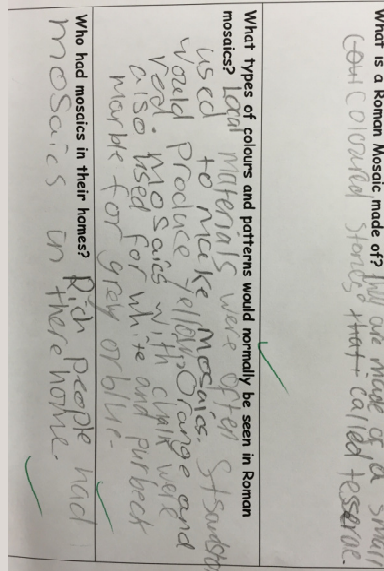
Curriculum news:
