Next Thursday, all children will have a session with their new teacher for next year. We will also send home a letter detailing the arrangements on the same day.

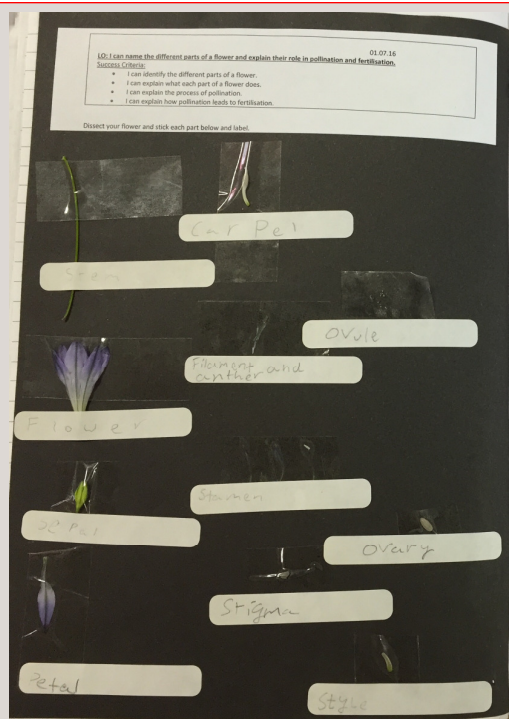
End of year reports:
