## Agincourt 600 Concert for Year 4, 23rd October 2015:

Next Friday Year 4 will be taking part in a brand new semi-staged and participatory musical composed by Richard Brown, who was for many years the musical director of the Royal Shakespeare Company, to celebrate the 600th Anniversary of the Battle of Agincourt. The concert will be staged at St. George's church on Friday 23rd October (10.30am), just before the battle anniversary. The music is specifically written for children and, while celebrating the victory, it will finish with the wedding of Henry and Catherine and the unification of the Kingdoms of France and England. Agincourt 600 are generously funding the project and is entirely free to take part in. When Henry V returned to London after the battle he was met at Blackheath by the Lord Mayor and 24 aldermen who invited him into the city. He travelled down the old Dover Road (Old Kent Road) and was met by the clergy of Southwark at the steps of St. George the Martyr. 1,000 children, who live on or near the route Henry V took upon his return, from several Southwark schools will take part. There will be ceremony, pageantry, battle and actors who, being accompanied by a fantastic live band, will immerse the children in a spectacular and memorable show.
