School Travel Plan 2015-16

We have achieved a GOLD award for our School Travel Plan (which is run by Transport for London, but is country wide). The aim is to reduce car use and improving safety on the journey to school, following consultations with pupils, staff, parents and Governors. At school, some of the activities included: journey surveys, outings, road safety theatre shows, installed more scooter/bike racks, cycling proficiency courses, scooter workshops, walk to school charts and badges etc. An added bonus is the promotion of active, healthy, safe and sustainable travel. Only 11 schools in Southwark attained this mark, so a BIG thank you for encouraging your child/children to walk/bike/scooter to and from school, let's keep up the good work!!
