Parent questionnaire:

The deadline for the return of the 2016 parent questionnaire was on Tuesday of this week. Thank you to all those parents who took the time to fill the questionnaire out. We had a total of 75 questionnaires returned (35% of the school role) which is the highest return since 2009. 36 more surveys were completed than at the OFSTED inspection in June 2015. Results will be analysed and findings shared with staff, Governors and parents.

School house project:

Simon Camp from ACA (our architect) presented plans for the school house development at a parent coffee morning last Friday. The slides he showed us can be viewed in the useful information part of the Noticeboard section of the website. A planning permission application will be submitted over the Easter break and we will wait for the project to be formally agreed.
