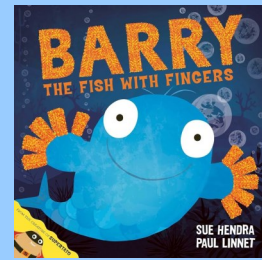

1st Place Attendance: Year 5

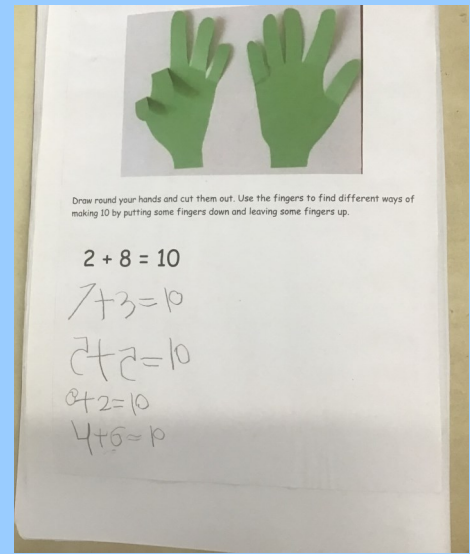
