On Monday, Year 5 enjoyed a wonderful trip to the British Museum, exploring what life was like in **ancient Greece**. The children studied images on Greek pottery, handled objects and worked in groups to bring scenes from history to life with their own creative tableaux.

A particular favourite was the discovery of a 'strigil' - a metal tool once used with olive oil after exercise - which gave everyone a fascinating glimpse into **ancient customs**. Then we toured the galleries on Greece 1050 - 520 BC, marvelling at pottery, sculpture and jewellery up close.
