Key Vocabulary:

Nursery Rhymes, song, sing, sound, rhyme, rhythm, beat, tap, loud, quiet, fast, slow, dance, move, stop, same letter, same sound, funny, strange, characters

How will the topic link to our community? How will social, moral, spiritual & cultural links be made?:
