The children were excited and amazed as they explored real mummies, including the famous (naturally preserved) Gebelein Man, and discovered fascinating funerary objects such as canopic jars, amulets and shabti figures, which were placed in tombs to help the deceased in the afterlife. They were also captivated by the spectacular Book of the Dead.
