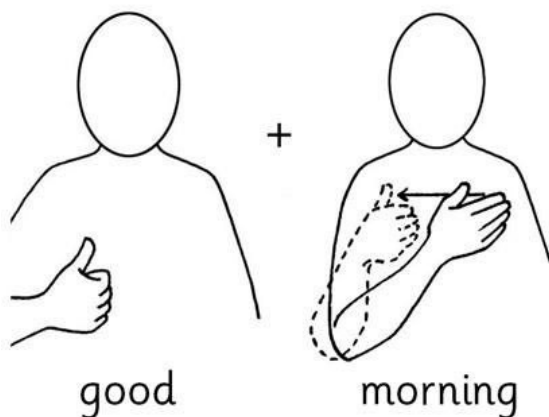


## Friday 17th April 2026
