## HEAT HEALTH UPDATE

This week temperatures are due to reach 32-33 °C. The heat health measures we currently have in place are: relaxed uniform – shorts and t-shirts, sunhats, sunscreen, water bottles, reduced outdoor playtime and adapted P.E. lessons/morning P.E. lessons. KS2 classes using the air-conditioned rooms on rotation as their rooms exceed comfortable and workable heat levels.

Other adjustments include:

**Summer Fair** – **POSTPONED TO TUESDAY 14<sup>TH</sup> JULY**. These measures have been taken due to lack of shade on playground and temperatures would be too high in the hall with the whole school community there.

**Friday's Dance Performance** – This will take place in the school hall with specific times for each class:

**1.30pm Nursery, Reception Year 1**

**1.50pm Year 2 and Year 4**

**2.10pm Year 5 and Year 6**

**Clubs** – **Football** is cancelled on Wednesday and Thursday. All other clubs (including **playcentre**) will run in the new build where there is air conditioning. Breakfast club will run as normal.

**School Lunch:** Lighter lunch and sandwich options available from tomorrow.

If you decide you would **prefer to keep your child at home** as they are struggling with the heat, please let the office know and this will be authorised and recorded appropriately on the register.  
**We will also call you if your child is struggling to cope with school in the heat.**

If you feel like your child would benefit from a **slightly shorter day** as a result of the heat, you can collect your child **at 1.30pm on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July.**
